1. Disclosure Compliance

- Annual Disclosure Certification Cycle: Dec1, 2025 to Feb 29, 2026
- Disclose/update: external activities, conflicts of interests, foreign travel, foreign affiliations
- All in Insight – launched Sept 2nd

2. Prevent Research Misconduct

- New ORI regs effective January 2026
- Emory Research Misconduct Policy 7.8 revised and updated
- Get an iThenticate account
- Report any falsification, fabrication, plagiarism concerns, questions to rio@emory.edu

3. Research Security

Mandatory Research Security Training effective Dec 1, 2025

- Meets fed requirements for Research Security Programs in accordance with NSPM-33
- Includes : Other Support, Research Cybersecurity, Foreign travel security, disclosure compliance
- 1 Module: 30-45minutes (accepted by NIH, NSF, DoD, USDA, DOE)
