#### International SOS (ISOS) Travel Assistance and Support

Emory partners with ISOS to offer travel support including emergency medical and evacuation.

#### **Travel Alerts**

Registering your travel with Global Safety and Security will enroll you in alerts impacting your itinerary and safety.

#### Emergency Response

Global Safety & Security can assist travelers in an emergency.

## Program/Project Development

Consult experts on safety, security, and risk management related to international projects, programs, and initiatives.

#### **Travel Restrictions**

As of September 8, travel by faculty and staff to Israel no longer requires pre-approval by the Executive Travel Safety Committee (ETSC).

If you are traveling to Israel, it is still recommended to consult with Global Safety & Security to review your risks.

Travel to Israel for students, including graduate and professional, still requires approval by ETSC.
