 $\mathbb{E}^{\mathbb{P}^{-}}$  Biohazardous animal cages (ABLS2/3) must be labelled so that anyone who accesses the cages is aware of the pathogen being used in each biohazard cage. The label must be legible and contain the common or scientific name of the pathogen. Labelling with only the specific strain name is **not** acceptable.

- Personnel training: Education and Training Requirements Checklist
- Occupational Health & Safety annual clearance
- EHSO approvals: ensure that your approvals are current.

### **Protocol Submission deadlines**

The IACUC meets on <u>the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of the Month</u>. Deadlines for FCR review are the Wednesday one week PRIOR to the meeting date for the agenda to be disseminated to members. DMR reviews are rolling submissions and do not have a "deadline".
