		Required for all staff performing CO2 Euthanasia at EPC.

		Required for all staff performing survival surgery of rodents or nonhuman primates at EPC.

4.	Physica	al Methods of Euthanasia Training and/or Assessment (in person)
		An Assessment is required for all staff performing physical methods of euthanasia without
		anesthesia (ex. cervical dislocation, decapitation, etc.) at the EPC; training available upon
		request
